Welcome 23rd annual Invaders M.C. Saucer Run.

This is the second round of the "Off road & spaceways championship of the Universe." The "Nationals" and "Best of the West" pale in comparison to this somewhat epic event. We are honored with your presence!! Thank you for coming... good luck and have FUN!

COURSE MARKINGS: Pink ribbon and arrows will lead you around the course.

↓ Danger markings consist of down arrows and day-glow, one set usually placed 50 feet before and another on top of the danger. An "X" on a day-glow indicates a road crossing.

Multiples of anything indicate a bit more severity.

START: Start time is 9 AM.

Follow signs and arrows to the start. Bomb practice is from 1PM to 5PM Saturday and starts at 6AM Sunday (or as soon as the ambulance arrives). There will be a 5 ROW START (Exp., Int, Nov., Beg., and Quads) with each successive row being started as soon as the start area is swept.

Once the day-glow go up...bomb practice is over. If you decide to make another bomb run we will DQ you. We know who you are... we're from another planet.

CHECKS: All checks are stop checks. Please stop so our earthling check people can mark your fender card (remember be courteous to these people... we only pay them minimum wage).

TECH INSPECTION: Stickies and sparkies are required. Tech will be conducted next to the start line before the race.

If you don't have either of these items we suggest that you beg, borrow, or buy one from Art (he doesn't have green stickies).

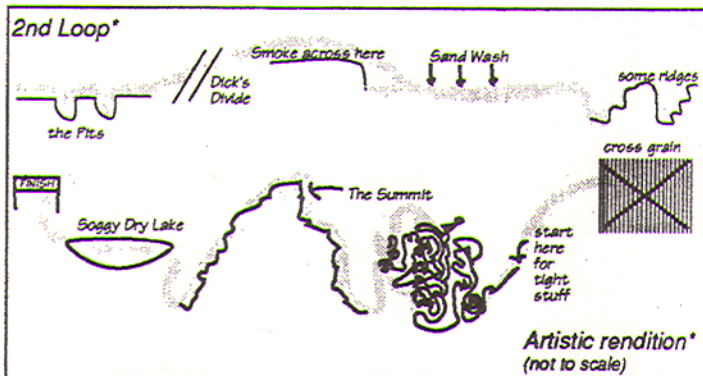
PITS: The speed limit is 15MPH in the pits. INJURIES/BREAKDOWNS: Rescue-3 will be here to assist you. If you see an injured rider please report the vitals to the next check. If you should break down, **STAY ON THE COURSE** and turn your bike around so the number is visible to other riders.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

FIRST LOOP: Al "Mexico" Guzman (the Sultan of SCORE) and Mike "Moose" Martin were the primary creators of the first loop. It has been designed to challenge those of you who are new to the sport and still allow you to be a productive member of society on Monday. Some of the scenic highlights: "Joe's Jam," "Wetly's whoops," "Burley's bash," and "bitchin' Boris' bodacious blast" are all out there somewhere... we're just not sure where! After check 2 there is a field to your right full of ribbon which is not ours. Stay on the road and follow the arrows to the end of the road. This loop is a fairly fast 48 miles.

SECOND LOOP: Former "trailbike class Wonder" Stevie "No Rebase" Webb and Vet ace Tom "Slick" Bradshaw teamed up on this one to give you a demanding 45 miles for the second loop. We are expecting to challenge you and the fun begins 2 miles out of the pits at "Dicks divide." You will smoke across the flats until you get to "9 mi. saddle" where you will negotiate a tight descent into a sandwash. A much longer sandwash takes you across some ridges where you'll negotiate a few miles of rocky cross grain. A few ridges, a wash or two, a "full zoot boogie" and the tight stuff begins. Lastly, we'll take you up the "mini summit" (just for you Baja fans), drop you down into the bowels of the earth and send you across Soggy dry lake on to the finish.
